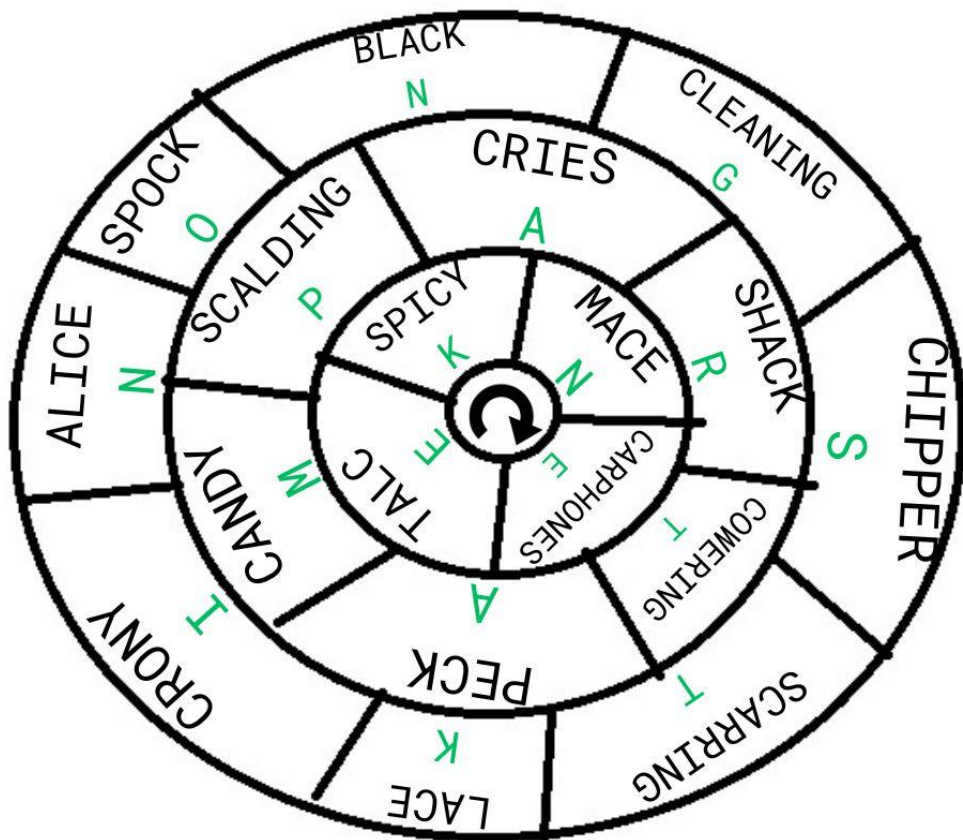

JOHN CENA'S JORTS-SOLUTION



This Bulls-Eye puzzle relies on a famous meme about Mr. Cena: namely, the phrase "U CAN'T C ME." The answers to the clues correspond to an entry in the bulls-eye grid, but the "C" in each bulls-eye word must be swapped out to find them. The answers are below; note that they're in alphabetical order for ease of solving.

- Certain kind of dress: ALICE/A-LINE
- Born under springy stars: CRIES/ARIES
- Forgetful artist: BLACK/BLANK
- Block out grunts: CARPHONES/EARPHONES
- Gather food or facts: CLEANING/GLEANING
- Alanis Morissette pressing clothes: CRONY/IRONY
- Superior sort in Michigan or Canada: LACE/LAKE
- Actress to see Moore of: CANDY/MANDY
- Animals with pride in their fur: MACE/MANE
- Successful mountaineer: PECK/PEAK
- Animal using Jaws of life: SHACK/SHARK
- Pair people or post packages: CHIPPER/SHIPPER
- A ball making sporting equipment: SCALDING/SPALDING
- Traders describing a volatile market: SPICY/SPIKY
- Ghostly ghoul: SPOCK/SPOOK
- Lead in a movie or play: SCARRING/STARRING
- Someone spinning a yarn: TALC/TALE
- Exceptionally tall, infernal person: COWERING/TOWERING

The next step is to place the changed letter in its corresponding section of the bulls-eye grid, which can be found on the next page.



As the clockwise arrow in the middle of the grid indicates, the answers should be read clockwise, roughly from the upper-left of each ring; Teen Titans solvers are given the bonus clue of the three starting point words—SPICY, SCALDING, and SPOCK—being in bold font. Reading each ring from center outward spells KNEE /PART AM/ ONGST KIN, or KNEE PART AMONGST KIN. This clue leads to the phrase ACL IN THE FAMILY; perform the “C replacement trick” one more time to get the answer **ALL IN THE FAMILY!**
