

All of the Blue Sky posts are references to people (or, in two cases, a mountain and a cat) with the same names as U.S. Presidents; the identity of the non-President is hinted by the username (in Justice League mode) or initials (in Teen Titans mode) at the beginning of each post, while the account name and hashtags are references to the Presidents themselves. As an additional clue, the posts are in historical order; the number of Reposts on each entry enumerates the President's first name, while the number of Comments enumerates the last name. Likes are used as an index into those last names to find your answer.

-CountryDaddy: George/Denzel Washington. Washington is the "Father of Our Country"; the post references Denzel's roles in *Remember the Titans* ("football...against Greek creatures"), *Training Day* ("trained longer than 24 hours"), and, in Justice League mode, *St. Elsewhere*; hashtags indicate Washington's warning against political parties and his role as a military general. Extracted letter: O

-ObnoxiousAndDisliked: John/Amy Adams. Adams famously described himself as "obnoxious and disliked" among his peers; the post references Amy's films *Enchanted* ("Andalasia"), *Big Eyes* ("facial features are a perfectly normal size"), and, in Justice League mode, *American Hustle*; hashtags indicate the song "Sit Down, John" from 1776 and Adams's Bostonian roots. Extracted Letter: D

-NAT20CON: John/Ashley Madison. Madison is the "Father of the Constitution" (CON); the post references the infamous Canadian-based dating site that openly declares it's for affairs, or "side pieces" as referenced in Justice League mode, with a nod to its marketing techniques that "thrive on publicity"; hashtags indicate the Articles of Confederation and Madison's belief in strong federal rights. Extracted Letter: D

-HickorySmoked: Andrew/Samuel L. Jackson. Jackson was known as "Old Hickory"; the post references Samuel L.'s tendency to swear in his movies, along with his roles in *Snakes on a Plane* ("reptiles on a level surface"), *The Avengers* ("plenty of initiatives, but none about vengeance"), and, in Justice League mode, *The Incredibles* ("WHERE'S MY SUPER SUIT?"); hashtags indicate Harriet Tubman replacing Jackson on the \$20 bill and his role in the Battle of New Orleans. Extracted Letter: S.

-GoDutchTreat: Martin/Abigail Van Buren ("Dear Abby"). Van Buren came from a Dutch family; the post references Abigail's role as an advice columnist and her sister Ann Landers, who wrote similar columns; hashtags indicate the claim that Van Buren

invented the term “O.K.” (for “Old Kinderhook”) and his later years in the Free Soil Party. Extracted Letter: B.

-BuenaVistaBoss: Zachary/Elizabeth Taylor. Taylor won a decisive victory at the Battle of Buena Vista; the post references Elizabeth’s eight marriages, fragrance line “White Diamonds,” role as Cleopatra, and, in Justice League mode, her famous purple eyes; hashtags indicate Taylor’s nickname of “Old Rough and Ready” and the fact that he was the first U.S. president to be elected with previously holding office. Extracted Letter: O.

-DownInFrontPorch: James Garfield/Garfield the Cat. Garfield ran a “front porch” campaign for president; the post references Garfield the Cat’s love of Italian cuisine (especially LASAGNA!), his hatred of Mondays, and, in Justice League mode, his owner Jon Arbuckle; the hashtags indicate Garfield’s role in the Battle of Shiloh and his membership in the “Half-Breed” coalition of his party. Extracted Letter: D.

-GlomOnGuam: William/Mount McKinley. The U.S. annexed Guam during McKinley’s presidency; the post references the National Parks Service and the debate over using Denali, the indigenous name of the mountain and an anagram of “denial”; the hashtags indicate McKinley’s adherence to the gold standard and the “Remember the Maine” slogan associated with the Spanish-American War. Extracted Letter: K.

-ALeagueOfOurOwn: Woodrow/Brian Wilson. Wilson was instrumental in creating the League of Nations; the post references The Beach Boys, including the album *Pet Sounds*, their song “Good Vibrations,” their genre of “surf rock”, and, in Justice League mode, the song “California Girls”; the hashtags indicate Wilson’s slogan of “He Kept Us Out of War” and his role as president of Princeton. Extracted Letter: I.

-KeepItCivil: Lyndon/Cave Johnson. Johnson signed the Civil Rights Act of 1964; the post references Cave’s title of CEO of Aperture Science in the *Portal* games and his legendary speech about life giving you lemons, with Justice League mode hinting at voice actor J.K. Simmons; the hashtags indicate Johnson’s Texas heritage and wife Lady Bird. Extracted Letter: N

LikeFatherLikeSon: George W./Kate Bush. Bush’s father George H.W. was also president; the post references Kate’s songs “Running Up That Hill” and “Wuthering Heights,” with a bonus reference to *Stranger Things* (which used the former) in Justice League Mode; the hashtags indicate the No Child Left Behind Act and Great Recession which occurred during Bush’s presidency. Extracted letter: S.

The answer is **ODDS BODKINS**, which is hinted in the flavortext with a reference to “mild swearing.”
