| March | Pancake Toppings Day | Cuddle a pet or loved one |
| April | Green Tea Day | Tell people to have |
| May | Eggplant Parmigiana Day | Go from one place to another |
| June | Blocks Party | Try to build a fire |
| July | Ash Tree Day | Dig in a sandbox |
| August | Wet Beast Day | Eat a cookie in the park |
| September | Afternoon of the Elves | Hide in a tower and make |
| October | Evening Gown Day | Party with ninety of your |
| November | Wobbly Stump Day | Shout or yell loudly |
| December | Upside-Down Day | Make a new crayon color |

If you then index the month number (January = 1, etc.) into both the holiday name and the observance, it produces PIRANDELLO'S BEST KNOWN PLAY, cluing the answer, **SIX CHARACTERS IN SEARCH OF AN AUTHOR**.
